## **COMP SAFARI (ALRC)**

### **Class Description/Applicability**

#### Standard

- 1 Leaf sprung. Up to 2000cc 4 cylinder petrol up to 2286cc diesel engine
- 2 Leaf sprung. 2001cc to 2495cc petrol or 2287cc to 2495cc diesel & LWB 2625xx 6 cylinder petrol
- 3 90 / Ninety / SWB Defender (petrol and normally aspirated diesel)
- 4 All models with turbo-diesel engines
- 5 Range Rover, Discovery, 110 / One Ten / LWB defender, Freelander, all FC's & LWB-V8 (petrol)

#### Modified

- 6 Leaf sprung up to 3000cc
- 7 Leaf sprung above 3000cc
- 8 Coil / air sprung up to 3600cc
- 9 Coil /air sprung over 3600cc

*NB Standard production vehicles from Land Rover Ltd, built after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1993, which do not have a competition class listed above are to be allowed in the class which nearest fits their specification.*

## **COMP SAFARI (OPEN – One Day Events Only)**

- 1 Independent Suspension (all engines)
- 2 Coil Sprung over 4 litre
- 3 Coil Sprung up to 4 litre
- 4 Coil Sprung Diesel (all engines)
- 5 Leaf Sprung (all engines)
- 6 Production Vehicles (all engines) \*

\* Entrants in class 6 will be allowed at the discretion of the scrutineer

## **COMP SAFARI (OPEN – Two Day Events Only)**

- 1 Production Vehicle - (MSA handbook)
- 2 Modified Production Vehicle - (MSA handbook)
- 3 2 Wheel Drive Vehicles
- 4 4x4 Diesel Vehicles - other than Independent
- 5 Independent Suspension - all engine sizes
- 6 4x4 Non Independent - up to 2501cc
- 7 4x4 Non Independent - 2502cc to 3600cc
- 8 4x4 Non Independent - 3601cc to 4300cc
- 9 4x4 Non Independent - 4301cc and over

## **TYRO (Classes and Definitions - as used by S&S LRC)**

- 1 Showroom Vehicle *(a vehicle that conforms to the specification of one that could be or still can be bought new from a LR dealer)*
- 2 Modified Vehicle *(all other vehicles)*
- 3 Unqualified Driver *(an eligible driver who does not hold a valid British driving licence – this can include children from the age of 13 yrs)*
- 4 Novice Driver *(an eligible driver, holding a full licence, who has not taken part in an ALRC trial within the last two years)*

***NB Under new rules from the ALRC one person can navigate for two drivers in the TYRO only. But please note that a driver cannot navigate for another driver in all events and a navigator cannot sit in with more than one driver.***
