E.6. BUMPERS

E.6. In modified RTVT classes the use of non-Land Rover heavy duty or winch bumpers are permitted so long as they are no smaller, weaker or more flexible than the original.

ROLL CAGE REGULATIONS

5.2 The front hoop should run across the width of the vehicle and the top part must not lean back any further than the angle of the windscreen. Bends may be used on the connecting bars between the front and rear hoops but should not have more than 4" / 100mm between 'a' and 'b' as shown above.

The angle of the windscreen should be that of a 90/110 for any Series or Defender vehicles or the actual angle on other types.
