During his stay, Tory volunteered at different organizations to better understand how a short term missions team could get involved.

The last thing we want to do is come in and do things the American way and not be effective. The time and money to go over there was well worth it," says Tory about the trip.

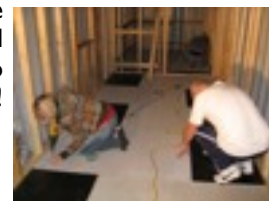
