

## Local Independent Feature Film in Post-Production, looks for funding.

*The independent film company, SpenceTF Productions™ LLC filmed "Guilt & Sentence" in the Summer of 2009. Now the company is starting to promote the film to the local area first, before branching out to the rest of the State and Country. Slowing the process of post-production is a lack of funds. **Morrisdale, PA, December 18, 2009** -- SpenceTF Productions™ LLC has recently completed principal photography (filming) of its second independent feature film, "Guilt & Sentence". It involves actors and actresses of all ages from Clearfield and Centre County, and has been filmed entirely in central Pennsylvania. This film will premiere at the historic Rowland Theatre on June 18, 2010 and multiple other screenings, as well as compete on at film festivals both nationally and internationally will follow.

"Guilt & Sentence," formerly known as "Second Chances," has a cast and crew of over 75 participants. We finished principal photography on August 29, 2009 and the film is now in the post-production stage of development. The predicted run time of this film will be around 2 hours and will be appropriate for a PG-13 rated audience. Kristyna Smulligan, one of the supporting leads, commented on her experience and said, "There's twists and turns and a little something for everyone!"

The storyline is a thought-provoking drama of two lost and troubled individuals who are forever entwined after a traumatic event occurs. Janis, a twenty-year-old woman who is struggling with depression, takes the blame for Peter, who works as a social worker hiding a troubled past. This film explores different sides of human nature, such as the effect of paranoia, suspicion, and the weight of guilt and its consequences. The story explores the question of soul-searching and shows the power of true redemption.

SpenceTF Productions™ LLC is an independent film company. The budget was carefully developed in pre-production stages and amounts to \$25,000, yet we still need funding for distribution and for our premiere. This is far below any Hollywood main-line industry film, which never goes below 3 million dollars. The producer Jason Spanogle commented, "Although our budget is far below industry standard, we as an independent film company, have the opportunity to allow friends and the community to partake in supporting the local arts." He went on to say, "We see this as a chance for anyone to become part of local, independent film. Any contribution is greatly appreciated and will be properly recognized."

The cast and crew had a great time making this film, and yet they were under an incredible amount of pressure to film it all in just two weeks. "I hope that this film's message can have the chance to reach a large audience and impact many," said Spencer T. Folmar, president director of SpenceTF Productions™ LLC, "We do not only want to ask for donations, but also to simply inform the local areas of this opportunity to experience art with meaning."
