The coach is responsible for the conduct of anyone on their sideline. This includes players, spectators and themselves. Please cooperate with any coaches requests (for staying behind spectator lines, language cautions etc).

Know that you can always discuss any issue with the club's Board of Directors. If you have any complaints or problems, they should be submitted to the board in writing (you are guaranteed a response). Parents, please do NOT do your own coaching. Yelling anything other than encouragement from the sidelines usually only causes confusion and makes it difficult for the coach to lead the team. If you do not agree with your coach or would like to offer suggestions, please do so after the game or practice and away from the team. Players can learn the value of being part of the team by following instructions. This benefit is lost when players are in conflict over who they should listen to.
