District Assembly to be Hosted at New Hemet Church

This year's District Assembly will be held in the brand new location/facilities of our church in Hemet. The church has been working toward the completion of their major relocation project for several years and plan to have their first service in the new worship center on Sunday, March 8. On March 1, the congregation worshipped on the patio in front of the new building due to the fact that the Fire Marshall had not completed the final safety inspection.

The annual convention/assembly events will begin with the District Nazarene World Mission Convention on Wednesday, June 3, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 pm. The District Assembly begins at 7:00 pm on Wednesday with General Superintendent Jerry Porter speaking. The Assembly continues at 8:30 on Thursday morning and concludes with the evening service, A Celebration of Ministry and Ordination. Eight candidates are expected to be ordained to the God called ministry in that service. Each church will receive an informational packet including recommended motels/hotels, and other important information in a few weeks.

Pastoral Changes

During the last few months, several of our churches have installed new pastors:

Colton: Pastor Dwayne Ross retired from pastoral ministry at District Assembly time. The Colton congregation had a connection with Pastor Robin Hyde and the San Bernardino Cornerstone congregation. The Colton Church Board and Cornerstone Church Boards agreed to have Pastor Robin Hyde serve as Senior Pastor of both churches. Pastor Hyde began at Colton on June 22.

Rialto: Pastor Frenchie Rivera ended his ministry at Rialto in June. Pastor Don Dyke was elected and subsequently installed as Senior Pastor on Nov. 11. He and his wife, Raylene, formerly pastored the Banning Church.

Indio Las Palmas Community: Pastor Duane Yoesel was serving Indio as Interim Pastor when he was nominated to be called as Senior Pastor. He received a unanimous congregational vote. He formerly pastored the Indio Church from 1988 to 1993. Pastor Yoesel and his wife, Pat, were installed on Nov. 23.

Holtville: Pastor Sam Holt completed his ministry in Holtville in June. He and his wife, Elida, are now active members of the El Centro Church. The Holtville congregation is unique in that their worship service is done in English and Spanish. They were looking for a pastor who could preach in both languages. Juan Castro, a member of the Murrieta Gateway Hispanic congregation in ministerial preparation, began serving the Holtville Church as one of their regular guest preachers. He was elected to serve as Senior Pastor on Feb. 15 and began his ministry as Senior Pastor that following week.

Riverside Arlington Avenue: Following the resignation of Pastor Travis Marshall, the Arlington Avenue Church Board voted to ask the District Superintendent to appoint Dr. Jack Eyestone as their interim Pastor. He began his ministry the first of December. In February he was nominated and elected to serve as the regularly called Senior Pastor. Dr. Eyestone is the former pastor of the Bloomington Church. He retired from the Superintendency of the Missouri District two years ago. We welcome Jack and Margaret back the SC District.

Murrieta Gateway: At last year's District Assembly Rev. Kenn Coil retired from the Senior Pastorate of the church he founded nineteen years earlier. Dr. Bill Grigory and his wife, Theresa, were installed as Senior Pastor of the Gateway Church on February 22. They come to our district from Newport, OR where they have served for eleven years.

San Diego Linda Vista: Rev. Carl Baker is serving under a one year appointment. Pastor Chuck Perry and his wife, Valerie, accepted a pastorate at Sisters, OR this past summer.

Eagle Mountain/Desert Center: Rev. Diane Mossbarger is serving as appointed Interim Pastor following the retirement of Pastor Roy Burdick.
