

DRESS CODE

GIRLS

Skirts and Dresses- Must be loose fitting and come to the middle of the knee when sitting, standing, or walking. Slits may not be higher than the required hem length. Dresses with low necklines in front or back or leather skirts may not be worn. Skirts and dresses made of denim are not to be worn by girls in grades seven through twelve.

Blouses and Shirts- All tops must be loose fitting and modest. T-shirts, low necklines in front or back, and tank tops are not permitted. All blouses and shirts must have collars and sleeves. Only small logos can be displayed in the top left area of the shirt.

Hose and underclothing- Girls in grades nine through twelve must wear hose unless instructed differently by administration. Hose are not necessary when wearing ankle length skirts or dresses.

Hair and Makeup- Hairstyles which look punk, masculine, or having contrasting colors are not acceptable. Nails are not to be painted in neon, dark, or odd shades. Junior and senior high girls may wear makeup in moderation.

Jewelry- Long or large dangling earrings are not to be worn. Earrings must match and be worn in both ears.

BOYS

Pants- Dress pants that are neat and evenly dyed are acceptable. Pants must not have more than five pockets and must fit with the band at the students waist. Belts must be worn if the pants have belt loops.

Shirts- Must be tucked in and have traditional collar. Only small logos can be displayed in the top left area of the shirt.

Shoes- Dress shoes, Hush puppies, loafers, etc., are acceptable.

Hair- Must be neatly trimmed, tapered, and off the ears, eyebrows, and collar. Crew cuts should be tapered evenly over the whole head. Hairstyles with contrasting colors are not acceptable. Traditionally styled haircuts are required.

Jewelry- Watches and rings are the only acceptable jewelry for boys. Ears may not be pierced.
