

Dress Code

It is our desire that the students of Spring Hill Christian Academy reflect the Lord Jesus Christ in their appearance. Our dress code is designed to assure that our students are dressed appropriately for the classroom. The Academy reserves the right to handle questionable cases not specifically outlined in the dress code policy on an individual basis. In most cases, if a student is out of dress code they will not be allowed to attend class until the problem is corrected.

All uniform attire listed below must be purchased through the school office or www.frenchtoast.com (depending on the item). Please label all items with your child's name.

Girls K3 through Third Grade

Navy blue walking shorts or skorts
Light blue monogrammed polo shirt

Plaid or navy blue jumper (knee length)
Light blue monogrammed polo shirt
White or light blue monogrammed Peter Pan blouse

White or light blue anklets covering the ankle, knee socks or tights (leggings may be worn in cold weather)
Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles.
Solid white or black laces
Blue or black Mary Janes (no boots)
Navy blue or black belt (First through Third Grade)

Navy blue or white cardigan sweater or SHCA sweatshirt for classroom use.
Long sleeved solid white or light blue shirts may be worn under regular uniform attire. Collar may be crew
or turtleneck. This is to accommodate during cold weather.

Chapel Day Attire: (First through Third Grade)

Plaid or navy blue jumper (knee length)
White or light blue monogrammed Peter Pan blouse
White or light blue anklets, knee socks or tights
Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles.
Solid white or black laces
Blue or black Mary Janes

Girls Fourth through Fifth Grade

Navy blue walking shorts or skorts
Light blue monogrammed polo shirt
Plaid or navy blue jumper (knee length)
Plaid or navy blue kick pleat skirt (knee length)/Long khaki skirts.
White or light blue monogrammed oxford shirt or Peter Pan blouse
Camisoles or full-length slips must be worn

White or light blue anklets covering the ankle, crew socks, knee socks or tights
Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles.
Solid white or black laces
Blue or black Mary Janes
Navy blue or black belt

Navy blue or white cardigan sweater or SHCA sweatshirt for classroom use
Long sleeved solid white or light blue shirts may be worn under regular uniform attire. Collar may be crew or turtleneck. This is to accommodate during cold weather.

Chapel Day Attire:

Plaid or navy blue jumper (knee length)
Plaid or navy blue kick pleat skirt (knee length)
White or light blue monogrammed oxford shirt or Peter Pan blouse
White or light blue anklets, crew socks, knee socks or tights
Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles. Solid white or black laces
Blue or black Mary Janes

Girls Sixth through Twelfth Grade

Navy blue A-line skirt/plaid kick pleat skirt/navy blue kick pleat skirt (knee length and loose fitting)
Long khaki skirt
Light blue monogrammed polo shirt
White or light blue monogrammed oxford blouse
White or light blue crew socks or anklets that cover the ankle, knee socks or nylons
Camisoles or full-length slips must be worn

Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles. Black or white laces.

Dress shoes with no strapless backs and heels no higher than 2 inches may be worn.

Navy blue or white cardigan/zip sweater or SHCA sweatshirt for classroom use
Long sleeved solid white or light blue shirts may be worn under regular uniform attire. Collar may be crew or turtleneck. This is to accommodate during cold weather.

Chapel Day Attire:

Navy blue A-line skirt/plaid kick pleat skirt/navy blue kick pleat skirt (knee length and loose fitting)
White or light blue oxford blouse
Nylons
Dress shoe with no strapless backs and heels no higher than 2 inches

Gym Attire:

SHCA t-shirt
SHCA shorts that are loose fitting and knee length

In addition to the above, each girl must meet the following criteria:

Hairstyles must be in good taste. At no time are girls allowed to alter the color of their hair from a natural color. No bandanas or handkerchiefs. Hair acceptance is at the discretion of administration.

Makeup cannot be used for girls under Sixth Grade.

No fake nails for girls under Sixth Grade.

Nail polish must be in good taste. No loud colors (neon colors, black, etc.) are permitted.

No chokers. Bracelets must be silver or gold and are limited to one/One watch

One necklace may be worn for girls Sixth Grade and above.

Earrings are to be limited to two per ear worn in the lower part of the earlobe.

Hoop earrings are to be no larger than a quarter in diameter. No dangling earrings are permitted.

Tattoos of any kind are not permitted.

Body piercing or cartilage piercing is not permitted.

Rings are limited to one per hand.

Shirts worn under the school uniform must be tucked in so as not to be visible.

Lunch Box, Book Bag and Personal Items Policy

Lunch Boxes or Bags

Students are to use only boxes or bags that have no characters, pictures or slogans.

Book Bags

Students are to use only bags that have no characters, pictures or slogans. Students are not to have rolling bags due to excessive wear on the facilities and difficulty of getting these types of bags up the stairs.

Personal Items

Students are not to bring toys, games or other personal items that are not part of the supply list that was distributed at the time of enrollment.
