"But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and for ever. Amen." (2 Peter 3:18)

Only Christ Can Set Us Free

When the Lord spoke to His hearers of the freedom that He gives His people as He reveals truth to them, He said, "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:32). The unbelieving Jews answered by saying, "We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest Thou, Ye shall be made free?" (John 8:33). This is one of Satan's greatest deceptions. A famous author once said, "The best way to keep a prisoner from escaping is to make sure he never knows he is in prison." Unbelievers are in bondage to Satan, sin, and the deception of self-righteous works and religion. It is Christ Who reveals the truth of this spiritual bondage to us and sets us free by showing us His way to save us by His grace. In and by Christ, we are set free from the law's power to curse us and condemn us and from sin's power to kill us. In Christ, we are totally forgiven of all our sins by His blood and declared perfectly righteous by the merits of His obedience unto death as our Surety, Substitute, and Redeemer. This sets us at liberty to serve Him as we are motivated by grace, gratitude, and love. When Christ sends the Holy Spirit to reveal the grace and power of His glorious Person and finished work on the cross, He sets us free to be "the servants of righteousness," which is a bondservant of Christ (Rom. 6:18). Christ then indwells us by His Spirit and His Word to keep us in this liberty forever, and He tells us to "stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage" (Gal. 5:1).
