As part of the Gift Aid Scheme it is now possible for charities to reclaim the tax you pay on your donation if you are a basic rate taxpayer. ## New Gene Identified

The Liver Unit and the Molecular Genetic research team at the University of Birmingham have found a number of defective genes which cause inherited liver disease.

The research team worked for genetic clues to these diseases by identifying more than twenty possible genes in each condition, eventually pinpointing the defective gene. This allows us to counsel families about future children and also to find out ways of treating these fatal disorders.

We hope that understanding these genetic mechanisms will help us understand more common liver conditions, such as biliary atresia.
