## Sixth Sunday of Easter - Year B May 5, 2024

NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

The WaveCAST app allows listeners to hear the audio on their personal, Wi-Fi connected devices, such as a mobile phone. The WaveCAST App can be downloaded from Google Play for Android devices or the Apple App Store for iOS devices.

Open the "WaveCAST Audio Receiver" App

Select Network: Hearing Assist Password: (none needed) Once connected to the network, the Hearing Assist Device will pop up in your list on the WaveCAST app. Tap on it and adjust your volume. (If using headphones, be sure to have them hooked up to your phone before selecting the WaveCAST app or it will announce the sound out loud.)
