

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIVINGWATERS™ REFRIGERATOR FILTER

Your refrigerator/ice-maker filter is made of quality components and properly cared for, will last for many years. It incorporates the finest Doulton Ultracarb™ Drinking Water Cartridge that is capable of removing 99.99% of pathogenic organisms and will make the water dispensed from your refrigerator taste and smell great!



To install, all that is necessary is to mount the housing on the back of your refrigerator close to the ¼" line that supplies water to it. Notice that the top of the housing has an arrow that indicates the direction of the water flow. Cut the line at a place that has some slack and insert the end that goes into the refrigerator on the side of the housing that is toward the head of the arrow. This is the "out" or treated water. The line that came from the untreated water supply goes to the tail of the arrow. The patented John Guest fittings will accept either ¼" copper or plastic line. Simply push the tubing into the fitting until you feel it "bottom" into the fitting. This

will provide a secure, leak-proof connection without the need for wrenches or additional tightening. To remove the tubing, simply hold in the small collar next to the tubing with a fingernail so it doesn't move with the tubing and pull the tubing out.

To insure clean, sparkling water, make sure change the filter annually.
