Legacy - According to "Webster", means "a gift received from, or passed down by an ancestor or predecessor from the past." A wealth of racing knowledge, "a gift", has truly been passed down through the Allison's. In the path forged by Donnie, Bobby and Davey Allison, the Allison family's contribution to auto racing is reflected through the development of the Allison Legacy Race Car.

Most noted for the "Alabama Gang", the Allison family has been a part of NASCAR and stock car racing since before the time multi-million dollar sponsors made their way into the sport. In addition to racing, the Allison's are about family and down to earth values. According to the Allison Brothers, Kenny, Ronald, and Donald, sons of the legendary Donnie Allison, the new Legacy Car is a tribute to all the Allison's in the family who have driven, owned, and turned wrenches on race cars, or who have been involved in racing in any fashion.

The founding trio of Allison Brothers Race Cars, Inc. is known as champion racecar builders. The Allison Legacy Car is built from a family of pure racers and brings with it a familiar look for the new generation of race fans. "Our family raced," explains Kenny Allison. "We've owned several race cars and we know what's involved with the costs. We wanted to give people a quality product at a decent cost, and decent maintenance costs. Also, we wanted to give the people in the grandstands something they could relate to."

The Allison Legacy car is a down sized version of a Nextel Cup stock car. The identification currently drawn by competitors and fans has already proved to be a winning combination throughout the past four seasons that the cars have been in competition.

The Allison family name continues to be a favorite among race fans today as Donnie and Bobby Allison play a vital role with the continuous growth of NASCAR. Carrying on a Legacy in racing, a new generation of race fans and competitors are developing with the Allison brothers. Today YOU have the opportunity to race into the future with the Allison Legacy Car Series, forging a new path toward an explosive level in auto racing.

The Car

The Allison Legacy car is a three-quarter sized replica of a NASCAR Sprint Cup Car and is powered by a four cylinder Mazda B2200 truck engine that produces approximately 125 horsepower. The cars use the standard Mazda five speed transmissions.

The cars weigh about 1,400 pounds dry but must weigh a minimum of 1,675 pounds with driver to race. The series is a "SPEC" series designed to minimize your racing costs and place the emphasis on the driver instead of the equipment.

"The Allison Legacy Cars are excellent equipment for the beginner to get his or her first exposure to racing," said David Pearson, winner of 105 NASCAR Winston Cup races. "They are well designed and professionally constructed cars that will give the drivers the same feel and experience they would get from a bigger and more powerful car."

The Allison Brothers, sons of former NASCAR competitor Donnie Allison, are the creators of the Allison Legacy car. Rules and National technical inspections are strictly enforced to limit alterations to the basic car. The engines are sealed and can only be rebuilt by Mark Smith at Tri-Star Motorsports, a Winston Cup Engine Builder. The engines are resealed before shipment back to the competitor. Almost all parts are spec and cannot be modified for competition.

The Series

The Allison Legacy Touring Series offers a professional to intermediate racing program. This unique and innovative program attracts drivers, new and old, with or without experience, and has proven to be a valuable stepping stone for drivers looking to further a racing career.

"It's important to offer a program for everybody who wants to be involved," explained Kenny Allison. "We are growing as a series and as a promotional outlet. Drivers are able to get valuable exposure and experience with our program that can contribute to furthering a racing career. At the same time, people who want to get into racing just for fun can maintain and operate the car in this series on a minimal budget, and with little or no experience."

There are approximately 22 Touring Races scheduled for 2009. Each event will be 50 laps or more in format. The Touring Series introduced road courses during the 2005 season. This venue proved to be highly successful and was enjoyed by the participants. There are approximately 150 regional events in different areas around the country.

Campaign Cost

Approximate cost per race to campaign an Allison Legacy car is \$200 per race. This includes tires, fuel, oil and most of the other normal maintenance items associated with a racecar. Once the car is set up to a driver's particular style or liking it becomes very low maintenance and can be easily serviced by an individual with normal mechanical skills.
