The Race Director will be responsible for overseeing all race day activities at all ALNRS sanctioned events. The ALNRS is a New England based touring division that tours in CT, MA, NY and NH and runs approximately 16 races per season from the beginning of April through the end of October.

The responsibilities of the Race Director will include but not limited to the signing in and collection of all entry fees from each driver at each event. The posting of the lineup for both the Heat and Feature events. The Race Director will be responsible for conducting a pre race meeting with all drivers and spotters before each ALNRS event. The Race Director will also oversee both pre race and post race inspection of all ALNRS race cars. The Race Director will work directly with the ALNRS Tech Inspectors to assure all cars pass inspection. During the event the Race Director will oversee the Race and with the assistance of the track officials make all calls as they pertain to the Comp Car of NC rule book.

The Race Director will be responsible for writing a brief synopsis of the race event which will be submitted to the ALNRS web master to be posted on the ALNRS site.

The ideal candidate should have a general knowledge of race procedures, be able to make fair and impartial calls regarding all racing incidents, work both as a supervisor and a team player and posses excellent communication skills.
