

Newburgh, NY Dec 08, 2008 - After taking several weeks off following the 2008 Season, ALNRS Director Michael A. Vasquez, Sr. is busy gearing up for the 2009 season. The series will once again return to New England's premier race tracks with races already scheduled at Lee USA Speedway and Monadnock Speedway. Michael states that although the 2009 Racing season is still several months away, the ALNRS management is busy working on their 2009 Season Schedule. With 8 races already on the schedule, Michael hopes to have the 14 race schedule completed shortly. At this time we are currently looking to hold two races per month starting in April and ending in October, were the series will once again end their season at the annual Octoberfest at Lee, USA Speedway. Also on the Schedule will be the first ever North/South Shootout at Rockingham Speedway in NC on the newly built ½ mile speedway which is similar to Martinsville Speedway. This will be a points race for the North Series and will put the North drivers up against some of the best Legacy drivers in the business. Michael also states that the ALNRS is once again planning a North/South Shootout at the Adirondack International Speedway the weekend of the Camping World East Series Race in late July. The complete details have yet to be finalized.

Also on the horizon will be the ALNRS annual appearance at the Speedway Expo in Springfield, MA, the weekend of Feb 27 - March 1, 2009. The series will have several show cars on display for the event, which is one of the top pre-season events in New England. So come out and see what the cars look like before they hit the track.

In other news, with both the 2008 ALNRS Champion Dylan Smith moving up to the late model division at Thunder Road and the 2008 **aDP** Rivet Rookie of the Year driver David Schneider moving up into a Modified division, the series will have several new talents behind the wheel of an Allison Legacy Race car in 2009. Both drivers sold their equipment to up and coming drivers in the North East. This will up the rookie class for 2009 to include five drivers, two of which already received some time behind the wheel of their ¾ scale cup machines.
