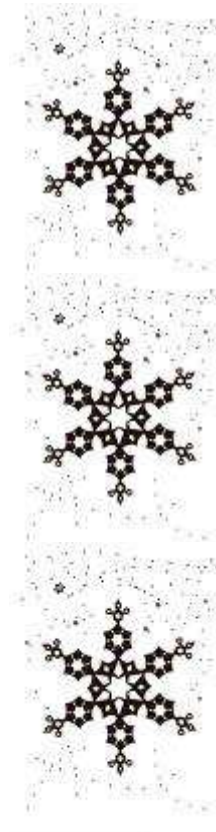
A Word From Pastor Fleagle

Congregation Elects Building & Property Ministry Team

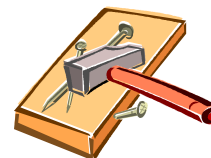
A NEW Team has been given the task of evaluating our property and building needs. In recent years educational space has been inadequate to facilitate adult, youth and children's ministries.

Children's Department

We have an urgent need for toddler workers, nursery workers and preschool teachers which is a **once a month** commitment—during either service. We also need a 1st hour 3rd and 4th grade teacher as well as a 1st hour 5th and 6th grade teacher.



We have begun our new curriculum with is entitled Faithweaver. With FaithWeaver, every child in Sunday school studies the same Bible lesson on the same day from different age-appropriate viewpoints. FaithWeaver is more than just learning Bible facts. It's understanding and applying God's Word to everyday life. FaithWeaver curriculum concentrates on authentic learning education, and every activity has a purpose in en-

couraging faith growth. Children experience the Bible stories and apply the principles in ways that they won't soon forget. Accompanying the students home are weekly handouts that reconnect the Bible lesson with life at home and at school as well as memory verses to hide away in their hearts. The older students also receive suggested daily devotional readings. They also receive a "Family Connect" page which provides

ideas and activities for the parents to follow along with the week's lessons and to interact with their child(ren) in implementing the lessons at home.

Through February we are going to be studying the amazing life and lessons of Jesus. Some of our key verses and themes can be found in John 1:12, Luke 19:10, and Luke 6:31.

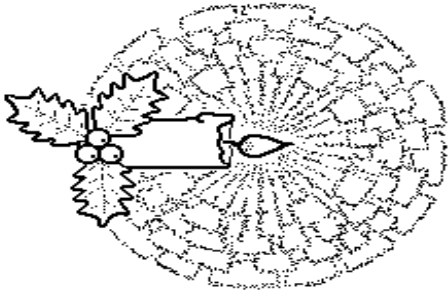
