

New Koinonia Groups Are Forming at Calvary!

Koinonia is a biblical Greek (Koine Greek) word with a variety of meanings and uses.

Here are two examples from the Bible:

“God is faithful; by him you were called into the fellowship (Koinonia/koinwni÷a^) of his Son, Jesus Christ our LORD.” 1 Cor. 1:9

“Those who are taught the word must share (Koinonia/Koinwnei÷tw) in all good things with their teacher.” Gal. 6:6

In 1 Cor. 1:9 Koinonia is used as a noun that suggests togetherness and involvement. In Gal. 6:6 Koinonia is used as a verb which conveys sharing with the implication of joint participation and mutual interest. Koinonia groups are small groups that meet monthly for study, fellowship, and mutual support. We have several groups that have been active for years and now we will be launching several new ones.
