What is Stephen Ministry?

Stephen Ministry equips lay people to provide confidential, one-to-one, Christian care to individuals in our congregation and our community who are experiencing difficulties in their lives.

Stephen Ministers multiply a congregation's ministry by providing emotional and spiritual care to those faced with a crisis or difficulty such as:

- Loss of a loved one
- Hospitalization
- Divorce or separation
- Loneliness or discouragement
- Spiritual crisis
- Unemployment or a job crisis
- A terminal illness
- Incarceration
- Aging
- A chronic illness or disability
- Birth, adoption, miscarriage or infertility
- Relocation
- Recovery after an accident or disaster
- And many more!!
