Welcome to our Worship this Lord's day!
We celebrate the Sacrament every Sunday at 7:45 am and at all services - 7:45 am, 9:15 am and 10:45 am - on the first and third Sunday of the month. We extend the Lord's invitation to His table to all baptized Christians who are repentant and wish to receive the crucified and risen Savior in the bread and wine of Communion. We welcome children who have not yet received First Communion instruction to come for a blessing. Non-alcoholic wine is white and is located in the center of the wine tray. Gluten free wafers are available for distribution from the communion station nearest the pulpit. See a pastor for details.

Reminder: If your child becomes restless during the service, there are speakers in the glassed-in hallway in the back of the Nave or you may take your child to our nursery. Changing tables are available in the bathrooms off of Fellowship Hall and off of the Chapel.
