## MLK COMMUNITY SERVICE

The Hickory Area Ministers and Greater Hickory Ministerial Alliance are planning the annual MLK Community Service that will be held at 5:00pm on Sunday, January 16, 2011 at Corinth Reformed United Church of Christ, 150 16<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW in Hickory. The speaker for the service will be Dr. Timothy Tyson, author of the award winning book *Blood Done Sign My Name*. In this outstanding personal history, Tyson, a professor of African-American studies who's white, unflinchingly examines the civil rights struggle in the South. The book focuses on the murder of a young black man, Henry Marrow, in 1970, a tragedy that dramatically widened the racial gap in the author's hometown of Oxford, N.C.

People of all ages are encouraged to participate in the community choir United Voices that will sing several selections during the service. Raymond Hollis, Minister of Music at The Favor Center, will direct the choir and is planning two rehearsals on Friday January 7 and Friday January 14, 2011 at 6:30pm, at Corinth Reformed United Church of Christ. 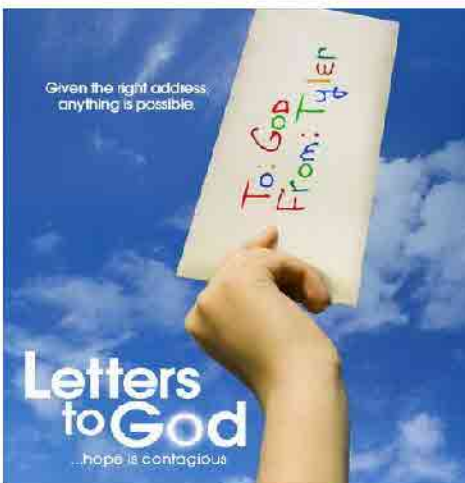
