Friends, it has been my joy to

have spent the past 16 months with you at FBC, Hickory! You are an interesting and wonderful collection of people. You welcomed me with opened hearts and arms—for which I am grateful. You even indulged my quirks and idiosyncrasies with patience. You often smiled and affirmed some of the things I've tried to preach and teach, and sometimes you furrowed your brows, scratched your heads, and even frowned. You did all of this for me, and I am

sure that you will do the same for your new pastor (just go easy on the frowns and furrowed brows!).
