1. All Exhibits must be made by the exhibitor from scratch. Premiums will not be paid for commercial products.
2. Please check schedule for **Intake Times**.
3. **Exhibitors may enter more than one baked good in a class using a different recipe base.**
4. ALL ENTRIES SHOULD BE LABELED, PLATED & PLASTIC COVERED ON DISPOSABLE PLATES.
5. **Exhibitors name cannot be on exhibit.**
6. Baked products will be sold in the Ag Building Annex, on Sunday Morning Opening Day of the fair beginning at 9:00 am.
7. There will be refrigeration available for those exhibits that require it. Please bring this to the attention of the building staff and they will assist you.
8. All Entries will be cut into and taste tested (unless otherwise stated) and put on display as required by the Department of Agriculture.
