**IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS AN EXHIBITOR TO READ AND BE AWARE OF ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**GENERAL RULES**

1. Registration forms complete with ear tag number and are due to the Fair Office by July 14<sup>th</sup> (4:00 pm) preceding the fair. Late registrations will not be accepted.
2. Registration is \$5.00 per head. Each exhibitor may enter up to 10 animals
3. **Each exhibitor is responsible for lanyard registrations.** Lanyard form links are located on our website <https://cambriacofair.com/> or <https://sites.google.com/view/american-legion-co-fair/home> If you have any problems accessing these sites please email us at **ccfair@verizon.net**.
  - Lanyard registrations submitted after July 14<sup>th</sup> will not be accepted. Exhibitor Lanyards are \$10 and Family Lanyards are \$20 each.
  - **NEW LANYARD DISTRIBUTION:** Lanyards must be paid for and picked up at the fair office Aug. 21 - 25 Monday thru Friday 9 to 4 or Saturday August 19<sup>th</sup> 12 to 4 pm. **Lanyards will not be available Livestock check-in day.**
4. Animals used in group classes must be entered and shown in individual classes.
5. All cattle must be haltered and led when unloaded, moving around the Fair Grounds, buildings, and when being loaded.
6. Cattle shall be identified by an official ear tag or other unique identification device approved by PDA. Official identification includes:
  - A USDA-issued National Uniform Ear tagging system or
  - A 15 digit Animal Identification Number (AIN) ear tag starting with "840" and having a US shield or
  - Other identification approved by the PDA
7. An accredited veterinarian MUST examine all animals and issue a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) within 30 days of arrival/check in at the Fairgrounds. The CVI must identify each animal and include the examination date. All animals must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this should be written on the CVI.
8. All animals must be accompanied by an approved Health Certificate (CVI) and bear unique identification.
9. Animals will not be admitted without the necessary health papers. All animals will be inspected before entering the barn. No animal showing evidence of contagious, infectious, or external parasitic disease shall be allowed entrance into the barn/show.
10. PA CATTLE ONLY - No tuberculosis test is required. No Brucellosis test is required.
11. VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS: Dairy Cattle include a health certificate, signed by an accredited veterinarian that includes a statement that the animal(s) identified have been immunized against IBR, PI3, and BVD. Animals that have never been vaccinated against BVD or have not been vaccinated against BVD during the previous 12 months, must receive one dose of modified live virus vaccine given at least 21 days, and not more than 180 days before the show, or two doses of killed vaccine, two to

four weeks apart, with the last dose given at least 15 days and not more than 180 days before the show. Animals that have been vaccinated against BVD within the previous 12 months must receive at least a single injection of modified live virus or killed vaccine given not less than 15 days and not more than 180 days before the show.

12. IMPORTANT! The date of the last live virus vaccination, or the dates of the last two killed virus vaccinations must be recorded on the Health Certificate.
13. Hyper immune serum may not be used as a substitute for the above vaccination requirement. No Animals will be admitted to the American Legion County Fair unless these requirements have been met.
14. All stalls must be cleaned upon the exit of your animal. It is not the superindendants responsibility to clean stalls, the exhibitor is responsible. Failure to comply will result in premium checks being held.
15. Entries will be released from the barn at 7 pm the last Saturday of fair week. Stall decorations must remain on display and maintained until the animals leave the grounds.
