# **GENERAL RULES**

# Exhibitors must abide by the Department of Agriculture's Health Requirements, along with General Rules and Regulations for all Exhibitors.

- 1. Registration forms are due to the Fair Office by July 14<sup>th</sup> (4:00 pm) preceding the fair. Late registrations will not be accepted.
- 2. Registration is \$5.00 per head.
- 3. Each exhibitor is responsible for lanyard registrations. Lanyard form links are located on our website https://cambriacofair.com/ or https://sites.google.com/view/american-legion-co-fair/home If you have any problems

- Lanyard registrations submitted after July 14<sup>th</sup> will not accepted. Exhibitor Lanyards are \$10 and Family Lanyards are \$20 each.
- NEW LANYARD DISTRIBUTION: Lanyards must be paid for and picked up at the fair office Aug. 21

   25 Monday thru Friday 9 to 4 or Saturday August 19<sup>th</sup> 12 to 4 pm. Lanyards will not be available Livestock check-in day.
- 4. All goats must be USDA tagged or USDA tattooed as recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database.
- 5. This identification must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) completed within 30days of check-in the health certificate.
- 6. Goats will be Does and Wethers.
- 7. Horns are permitted.
- 8. Exhibitors must produce a breed certificate for any goats that are being shown as purebreds.
- **9.** All grooming and fitting must occur in the Goat barn no exceptions. A light touch up consisting of a brush may be used preceding and during the show.
- 10. DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS:
  - Goat Stands/Show Boxes are to be kept in storage areas designated by the barn superintendents.
  - Stands/Boxes are allowed in the main aisle the night prior and the day of the show.
  - Stands/Boxes must be stored **promptly** after the show.
- 11. All decorations must be put on the back wall or attached to the steel wire where supplied. No decorations, awards or ribbons may be put on the stall or doors for the animal's safety.
- 12. All stalls must be cleaned upon the exit of your animal. It is not the superindendants responsiblilty to clean stalls, the exhibitor is responsible. Failure to comply will result in premium checks being held.
- 13. Entries will be released from the barn at 7 pm the last Saturday of fair week.
