**Baked Goods**

1. Exhibitors may enter more than one **baked good** in a class using a different recipe flavor unless otherwise stated.
2. All entries should be, named / labeled as to what It Is, plated on a disposable plate, and plastic covered, however **exhibitors name can not be on exhibit. Plates, trays, platters etc. Will not be returned. Please do not display on items that must be returned.**
3. Baked products will be sold in the Ag Building Annex, on Sunday Morning Opening Day of the fair beginning at 9:00 am.
4. There will be refrigeration for those exhibits that require it. Please bring this to the attention of the building staff and they will assist you.
5. All Entries will be cut into, (unless otherwise stated) and put on display as required by the Department of Agriculture.
