## Religion Class - Ideas for Service Hours (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>)

- Volunteer in the church nursery, VBS, etc.
- Usher, altar serve, sing in choir, reader, etc. at Church on the weekends (only count 1 hour)
- Go to adoration & offer up your prayer time for someone in need
- Do lawn work, house sitting, pet care for an elderly neighbor
- Babysit for free (not one's own sibling)
- Cook a meal for a sick friend or a sick neighbor, or bake cookies for the Fire Department, Police Stations, Church Food Pantry
- Peer Tutor during tutorials or outside school hour
- Write encouraging/thank you note to troops overseas or veterans, nurses, doctors, patients, teachers, etc.
- Read to younger children (ask the children's librarians at public library)
- Help set up/ clean up for a funeral luncheon; Make centerpieces, table decorations or wreaths for nursing homes, shelters, etc.
- Make prayer cards or spiritual bouquets for nursing home resident, soldier, funeral luncheon, newly married couple, new baby, etc.
- Teach another person to speak a foreign language (if you speak one)
- Be a pen pal with a veteran in a hospital, nursing home resident, child at another Catholic school, etc.
- Put together "hope bags" or first aid kits & distribute to those in need
- Participate in the walk-a-thon, St Jude's marathon, etc.
- Participate in our archdiocesan activities (Steps4Students, Middle School Youth Rally, Retreat)
- Record yourself & friends reading stories with the voices and donate the tapes to a day care or preschool program
- Take dictation for nursing home residents (write letters for them)
- Make a quilt, crochet/knit, etc. & donate to local shelter or charity (hats, socks, blankets etc.)
- Make rosaries, or holiday or birthday cards and deliver to nursing home residents
- Organize a food, clothing, toy drive
- Plant & maintain a flowerbed for the community (or school, church, neighbor, etc.)
- Stuff bulletins for church, change out missalettes for church
- Visit the local cemetery & pick up trash, fix knocked over flowers, etc.; pray for the dead
- Make rosaries and place in adoration chapels for others to enjoy
- Serve at capital campaign receptions, parish festival, etc.
