

# Dress Code for all SHCA Boys 2018-2019

It is our desire that the students of Spring Hill Christian Academy reflect the Lord Jesus Christ in their appearance. Our dress code is designed to assure that our students are dressed appropriately for the classroom, field trip, or any other activity sponsored by the Academy. The Academy reserves the right to handle questionable cases not specifically outlined in the dress code policy on an individual basis.

All uniform attire listed below must be purchased through the school office or at the link provided on the school webpage, ([www.springhillca.com](http://www.springhillca.com)) depending on the item. Please label all items with your child's name.

## Boys K3 through Fifth Grade

### Daily Wear Attire (Non-Chapel Days):

Khaki walking shorts and/or slacks (no carpenter or cargo pants)

Navy blue monogrammed polo shirt. Shirt must be tucked in.

Black, navy blue or white crew socks that cover the ankle. **"No show" socks are not permitted.**

Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles. Black or white laces.

No boots.

Black, brown or cordovan belt (First through Fifth Grade only) Belts are not to be studded.

Solid color Navy blue, grey, black or white cardigan/zip sweater or SHCA sweatshirt for classroom use.

Only SHCA name/logo is permitted on outerwear worn for classroom use. No other logos are permitted.

Long sleeved solid white or navy blue shirts may be worn under regular uniform attire.

Collars may be crew or turtleneck. This is to accommodate during cold weather.

### Chapel Day Attire:

"Docker" style business casual Khaki slacks (no carpenter or cargo pants). Uniform style slacks may be purchased locally or ordered through the SHCA Lands' End store on line. White monogrammed oxford shirt. Shirt must be tucked in.

Navy or plaid tie worn snug to the top button of shirt - **available through SHCA Lands' End store online.**

Black, navy blue or white crew socks that cover the ankle.

Black, brown, or cordovan dress shoes (no boots or tennis shoes)

Black, brown or cordovan solid colored belt (First through Fifth Grade only). Belts are not to be studded.

### In addition to the above, every boy in SHCA must meet the following criteria:

Hair must be cut above the eyebrows, ears and collar and must be neatly groomed.

Hair must not be colored, streaked, sculpted, tailed, shaved, extremely spiked or other faddish styles.

Hair must blend and not have any obvious hairlines or breaks.

Sideburns are not to be past the bottom opening of the ear.

Face must be clean-shaven.

Jewelry is limited to one ring and cannot be worn on thumb. One watch.

No necklaces of any kind. (unless medically necessary)

No earrings.

"Cause" bracelets (one per arm) may be worn upon approval by SHCA administration.

Tattoos of any kind are not permitted.

Body piercing is not permitted.

## **Boys Sixth through Twelfth Grade**

### Daily Wear Attire (Non-Chapel Days):

“Docker” style business casual Khaki slacks (no carpenter or cargo pants). Uniform style slacks may be purchased locally or ordered through the SHCA Lands’ End store on line.

Navy blue monogrammed polo shirt. Shirt must be tucked in.

White monogrammed oxford shirt. Shirt must be tucked in.

Black, navy blue or white crew socks that cover the ankle. **“No show” socks are not permitted.**

Predominantly white or black tennis shoes with no characters or light up soles. Solid white or black laces.

Solid color black, brown, or cordovan “Sperry” style shoes.

Black, brown or cordovan belt

Solid color Navy blue, grey, black or white cardigan/zip sweater or SHCA sweatshirt for classroom use.

Only SHCA name/logo is permitted on outerwear worn for classroom use. No other logos are permitted.

Long sleeved solid white or navy blue shirts may be worn under regular uniform attire. Collar may be crew or turtleneck. This is to accommodate during cold weather.

### Chapel Day Attire:

Khaki pants (no carpenter pants)

White monogrammed oxford shirt. Shirt must be tucked in.

Navy or plaid tie worn snug to the top button of shirt – **available through SHCA Lands’ End store online.**

Black, brown, or cordovan dress or “Sperry” style shoes (no boots or tennis shoes).

Black, navy blue or white crew socks that cover the ankle. **“No show” socks are not permitted.**

Black, brown or cordovan belt. Belts are not to be studded.

### **In addition to the above, every boy in SHCA must meet the following criteria:**

Hair must be cut above the eyebrows, ears and collar and must be neatly groomed.

## **Field Trip/Dress Down Attire for All Students**

*Field trips or special activities: Regular uniform or uniform walking shorts with school issued field trip t-shirt may be worn by all students during designated field trip or school activities. When this applies it will be announced by the teacher. Usual footwear policy per grade level will apply unless otherwise stated. When blue jeans are permitted for these kinds of trips, they must be blue, loose-fitting ("skinny jeans" or "boyfriend jeans" are not permitted). Jeans must not have holes or be low-rise style.*

## **Lunch Box, Book Bag and Personal Items Policy**

### Lunch Boxes or Bags

Students are to use only boxes or bags that have no characters, pictures or slogans.

### Book Bags

Students are to use only bags that have no characters, pictures or slogans. Students are not to have rolling bags due to excessive wear on the facilities and difficulty of getting these types of bags up the stairs.

### Personal Items

Students are not to bring toys, games or other personal items that are not part of the supply list that was distributed at the time of enrollment.

## **Dress Code Violations**

Any violation of the dress code may result in your child losing their privilege to attend classes. Repeated violations may result in your child being dismissed from the Academy. All decisions regarding dress code compliance will be at the discretion of the administration.

If a student is found out of dress code, the following procedures will occur:

### **Preschool and Elementary (Grades K3 through Fifth)**

- A Dress Code Noncompliance slip will be sent home describing the nature of the problem.
- A phone call will be made when necessary.
- A demerit will be issued in grades First through Fifth for repeated offenses.

### **Middle School and High School (Grades Sixth through Twelfth)**

- Student will be sent to the office if:

Not wearing basic uniform items for boy's-shirt or pant/ for girl's-blouse or skirt. Violations of hair coloring, hairstyle, or non-shaving.

\*Student will need to call parent so that the problem can be corrected. Parents are requested to bring needed items to the school as soon as possible.

- Student will incur referral points for repeated offenses.
