**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF
1997 PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SEVEN
SEATS ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF DUQUESNE**

WHEREAS, Council had previously found it necessary to have five members of the City's Planning Commission;

WHEREAS, Council wishes to have a diverse representation of the population of the City at all Planning Commission meetings; therefore Council has determined that increasing the number of Planning Commission members is necessary and desirable for diverse representation of the entire population.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by Council of the City of Duquesne, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. That the number of members of the Planning Commission shall be increased from five to seven effective upon adoption of the within ordinance in the manner described in Section 2 below.

Section 2. That the above-described increase shall be accomplished by appointing individuals to any vacancies on the Planning Commission until such time that the number is increased from five to seven members. Each term shall be for five years.

Section 3. That any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance, being the same, is hereby repealed insofar as the same is inconsistent with this ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and approval by Council as provided for in Sections 1 and 2 above.
