

## Confirmation Requirements

"The Sacrament of confirmation impresses a character and by it the baptized, continuing on the path of Christian initiation, are enriched by the gifts of the Holy Spirit and bound more perfectly to the church; it strengthens them and obliges them more firmly to be witnesses to Christ by word and deed and to spread and defend the faith" - Code of Canon Law 879

## **Requirements:**

- 1. You will have completed 3 years of high school religious education (CYM) with at least a 90% attendance. You must be registered and attend religious education classes.
- Attendance at Confirmation class is required. 100% attendance is expected. If you have a conflict please contact one of the confirmation catechists <u>prior</u> to the absence in order to make other arrangements. You will be expected to complete a written assignment in the event you are absent.

## 3. Regular attendance at Mass.

- **4.** Attendance at the Confirmation Retreat. This is a diocesan requirement and is <u>mandatory</u>; the date of the <u>*Retreat is January 19, 2020*</u>
- Baptismal information is needed for records. Please provide a copy of the baptismal certificate <u>by</u> <u>September 18, 2019</u>. If you receive the Sacrament of Baptism from St. Agnes let one of the confirmation catechists know. A copy of the original is sufficient.
- Each candidate will need to participate in a minimum of 20 hours of community service. Please see separate sheet regarding service hours for specific information. <u>Service hours must be completed by</u> <u>March 18, 2020.</u>
- 7. Select a sponsor who is willing to go through this preparation process with you. The sponsors are asked to attend the Confirmation formation sessions with the candidate. A sponsor must be a baptized, confirmed and an active member of the Catholic Church. In order for the candidate's sponsor to journey with the candidate through confirmation the sponsor needs to be selected early. <u>*Turn in the sponsor's name by September 18, 2020.*</u>
- If your sponsor is not a member of St. Agnes Parish, then the sponsor is asked to have their pastor send a letter stating that they are practicing and are indeed in good standing with the Church. <u>Letters</u> <u>must be received by January 22, 2020</u>. - 9. The Candidate will select a name for Confirmation. <u>*The Confirmation Saint Name form will be due February 5, 2020.</u>*</u>
- Each Candidate must submit a letter to the Bishop stating his or her decision to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. <u>Due date is January 8, 2020.</u>
