

Social Outreach/Prayer Ministries

Communion Ministry to Shut-ins: these ministers carry the Body of Christ from the church community to parishioners in their place of residence each week. Prayer Chain: Volunteers receive calls requesting prayers for a particular person or situation. Volunteer will pray daily or as often as possible until the request is ended. Divorce Care: Support group for the separated and divorced that meets weekly for thirteen sessions of video and sharing. The program helps people face challenges and move toward rebuilding their lives.

St. Agnes Altar Society: Every register woman of the parish 18 years or older is considered a member. Each member is asked to pick a season of year (fall, winter, spring, or summer) to volunteer for parish activities. General meetings will be held at least four times per year.

- Fall Dinner – Volunteers work with the Fall Dinner Director to plan, facilitate and clean up for this Annual Fund Raiser. Proceeds of this dinner will be determined by SAAS in communication with the Pastor.
- Funeral Dinner – SAAS arrive ½ to 1 hour prior to the time of the dinner, help set up, serve the dinner and remain afterward to help clean up (about 4 to 5 hours total)
- Food for Funeral Dinner – volunteers prepare a salad or dessert to serve 12 people and bring to the church before 10am on the day of the dinner.

Hospitality/Welcoming Committee: Volunteers work with the director to provide hospitality to new members and introduce them to the parish. Good social skills and creativity needed.

Lenten Friday Night Soup Suppers: Volunteers will prepare, serve and/or clean up for any or all of the suppers served after the Friday evening 6 PM Mass during Lent. Goal is to build community and raise funds for Catholic Relief Serves Rice Bowl project.

Lenten Fish Fry: Volunteers willing to prepare serve and/or clean up for any or all the fish fries during Lent. Goal is to build community and raise funds for the parish or school.

Spiritual Grind: Meets Sundays from 9:15-10:15 AM in the Assembly Room of the school to Break Open the Word – an informal discussion on the weekend readings. Spiritual Grind *Flavor of the Day* is served during the discussion! (October-April)

Young At Heart: A luncheon that is held the first Tuesday of each month. It is for those who are retired or of retirement age who wish to share a meal with others in our community. Participants will be asked to help clean up after one luncheon.

Men's Book Study: Men who gather Wednesdays at 6:30 AM in the Garden Room of the church to discuss selected books. Need to be willing to read a chapter a week for discussion. Coffee and rolls are provided by the men on a rotating basis.
