Dear Student and Parents,

Congratulations on having completed your graded examinations. Should you intend to continue your dance examinations at vocational or vocational graded levels, you are invited to become a member of bbodance at the first tier of membership being bbodance Student Membership. Although membership is not compulsory, it is financially viable to take out membership.

Should you decide not to take out membership but wish to continue taking examinations at vocational levels, please refer to the examination fee schedule and the Dance Days Fee schedule for non members. Places at Dance Days are initially reserved for bbodance Members. Non members at vocational level are not eligible for participation in any scholarships programs offered, also they are not able to audition or participate in the Associates Program. Our intention is to support our BBO members at all levels.

Membership is not offered for examinations taken from Pre Primary to Grade Five inclusive, but once students embark on the vocational examinations, membership to the BBO commences. The first tier being BBO Student Membership at Intermediate Foundation and Intermediate levels. This is followed by BBO Executant Membership at Advanced 1 & 2 levels, then to the Teaching Diploma levels to gain Teaching Membership and Registration.


We are delighted to see our students progress through the grades from young dancers to the skillful dancers we now see entering vocational examinations.
