Groups 1 and 2 – 4.5 miles
East Langton – Church Langton – Thorpe Langton

Leave the pub by running up past the cricket ground and at the T junction turn left. After a short distance turn right onto Church Causeway which leads into Church Langton. At the T junction in Church Langton turn right and pass the Hanbury School before leaving the village via the long downhill route which eventually leads to the junction with the Tur Langton to Cranoe road. Turn right here and follow the road for approx three quarters of a mile. You will come to a cross roads with the small hamlet of Stonton Wyville to your left. Ignore this and instead turn right onto the bridle road which forms part of The Leicestershire Round. Follow this route with some outstanding views until emerging in Thorpe Langton at the side of The Bakers Arms. Rejoin the road and turn right heading back to East Langton which is another three quarters of a mile and return to the welcoming sight of The Bell Inn



Groups 3 – 8.3 miles
East Langton – Thorpe Langton – Welham – Cranoe

Leave the pub by running up past the cricket ground and at the T junction turn right. Follow the road through Thorpe Langton and continue straight ahead following directions for Welham. Entering Welham carry straight ahead bearing sharp left at The Red Lion public house. As you leave the village keep to the left fork following directions for Cranoe. Follow this road for approx two miles and upon entering Cranoe turn left at the T junction following directions for Tur Langton. After approx two miles you will come to a cross roads with the small hamlet of Stonton Wyville to your right. Ignore this and instead turn left onto the bridle road which forms part of The Leicestershire Round. Follow this route with some outstanding views until emerging in Thorpe Langton at the side of The Bakers Arms. Rejoin the road and turn right heading back to East Langton which is another three quarters of a mile and return to the welcoming sight of The Bell Inn
