On December 4, a Christingle service will be celebrated at the Smithville campus. You might be wondering, "What is a Christingle service?" Well, it started in Germany in 1747 and gained popularity in the UK in the late 1960's. A Christingle is a symbolic object that means 'Christ's light'. It consists of an orange with a candle held in its centre and a red ribbon around it. Four sticks holding fruit and nuts or sweets are pierced into the orange. Please plan on attending this beautiful candle lit service. On December 11, Platte City will be celebrating with a Christmas Singalong Service. Come and join in the singing of classic Christmas songs we all know and love. Advent services are also scheduled for December 18, along with Christmas eve services on December 24. Christmas eve services in Platte City start at 6:30 and Smithville at 7:30.
