

Section 10 – Social Media Policies

10.01 – Social Media Policy

STUDENT USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

- A. Students may be held accountable for any text, post, tweet, chat, or other form of social media/phone application posting they make.
- B. Students must abide by the policies of any social networking site they use, including restrictions on age.
- C. Students shall not post anything that may be deemed inappropriate by a teacher or administrator. Students should also understand that college admissions counselors and future employers review the social media postings of prospective students and employees and should refrain from posting any offensive or inappropriate material.
- D. Students shall not post anything that is demeaning, mean spirited, or intended to harass or bully.
- E. Students shall not misrepresent themselves by using someone else's identity or creating a fake profile/person.
- F. Students shall not post or send electronically any images and/or videos of themselves that are of an explicit nature.
- G. Students should refrain from posting digital images of others without requesting permission from those in the photo or video.
- H. Students understand that they shall grant access to their electronic accounts (including, but not limited to social media and networking sites) upon request of administration.
- I. A student's access to school wifi is not guaranteed, students may be denied its use at any time.
- J. Students who do not abide by these terms and conditions will be subject to school disciplinary action.
- K. Students are not allowed to use social media for personal messaging during school hours or related school events.
