

## **Section 5 – Student Policies**

### **5.007 – Discipline Policy**

When a child experiences a classroom setback and is no longer able to participate with his/her peers, they are placed in a "safe setting." This allows the child to gain control.

In the rare event that a child is not able to gain control, the school will contact the parent/guardian for the child to be picked up and a behavior plan (developed by an education team including parents/guardians) may be put into place. The plan holds all parties accountable for positive intervention strategies with a planned approach to moving forward with education.

One aspect of a behavior plan may be to require counseling. If other processes have been used, professional counseling may be required for continued enrollment, at parent/guardian cost.

Administration has the final authority and may adjust this policy based on the situation.
