

Section 5 – Student Policies

5.08 – Dress Code

Our Savior Christian Academy has a standard of dress shaped by the biblical principles of modesty and countenance. These best practices are not meant to stifle creativity or one's personal choices. The goal is to focus on education while reflecting the incredible beauty found in God's human creation.

Students must be in compliance with best practices of dress prior to entering the building, which continues until the end of the school day. The school day includes special events, sports, and anything else sponsored by the Academy unless special dress is approved by the administration.

Best Practices

- All clothing must be properly sized, modest and unrevealing in cut and fit.
- Clothing and appearance should not draw undue attention.
- Wear shirts with sleeves.
- Wear shoes you can run in.
- Refrain from hats, and hoods while in the building.
- Coats may not be worn in the classroom. Sweaters or sweatshirts can be worn and kept in the locker to be used over your clothing on cooler days.
- Come to school looking well groomed, neat and clean.
- Refrain from dressing in a manner that could detract from learning or bring undue attention to yourself. This includes hair color, piercings or anything else in excess.
- Refrain from wearing pajamas or other sleepwear.
- Jewelry should be simple and reflect Christian principles. Satanic (including skull and crossbones) or anything with hidden meanings contrary to Holy Scripture should not be worn.
- Administration holds the final authority regarding anything worn to school or at sponsored events.
