

Section 5 – Student Policies

5.023 – Failure to Thrive

When every appropriate action has been taken, including parent and caregiver / school team support(s), and a child chooses not to perform, they may be deemed Failure to Thrive. In such a case, a clear plan should be designed to afford the student every opportunity to engage and redeem themselves academically. All things should be considered. If in fact, the student continues to disengage, does not meet the plan, or for anything else unforeseen, the Administrator has the authority to deny continued or future enrollment.
