The Sustaining Grace of God

"I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me" (Psalm 3:5). Could we imagine that our holy, just, and merciful God would save us by His grace only to leave us to ourselves to keep ourselves in His grace? Perish the thought. God saves His people and sustains His people by His power and grace based on the merits of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. God is gracious, powerful, and faithful to bring all of His chosen people to final glory. Christ died for them, paid their debt to God's justice, brought forth an everlasting righteousness which God has imputed to them. His righteousness cannot be taken away, and it cannot be contaminated by their sin. Christ ever lives to intercede for them so that they cannot be charged with sin and condemned by the law. God the Holy Spirit has given them spiritual life and indwells them to convict them of sin and drive them to Christ continually an eternally. The sustaining power and grace of God in Christ is enough to save all of His people to the uttermost, and they can never be condemned. Those who say that one whom God has chosen and justified by His grace in Christ, one whom Christ has redeemed by His death on the cross, one whom the Holy Spirit has given spiritual life and faith to believe in Christ, and one for whom Christ intercedes could ever lose that salvation and be lost eternally do not know the God of the Bible. They do not know the sustaining grace and power of God – *"Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen" (Jude 24-25).*
