## *“He That Hath Ears to Hear, Let Him Hear.”*

What do we know from God’s Word about those who have spiritual ears to hear and believe the glorious Gospel of God’s grace in the Lord Jesus Christ? We know that none of us have these spiritual ears by nature. We are all fallen in Adam and born naturally in a state of spiritual death and depravity. By nature, we have no spiritual ability to see, hear, and believe God’s Word in Christ. We know that if any have spiritual ears and hear (heed and obey) this Gospel, it is because God has given them spiritual life in the new birth (John 3:3-7; Prov. 20:12). We know that the hearing ear is evidence of belief of the truth that brings us to faith in Christ and repentance of dead works (Rom. 10:13-17). We know that all of this is the gift of God by His revelation of Himself in Christ as the Lord our Righteousness (Rom. 1:16-17). Do you have this hearing ear? Well, do you hear God’s Gospel with the ear of faith that causes you to cling to Christ alone in the glory of His Person and the power of His finished work, and turn away from your works and will? Then praise God, you are God’s workmanship of grace, not by your works or your will, but created in Christ Jesus based on His righteousness alone (Eph. 2:8-10).

## Reasons For Our Good Hope

The Apostle Peter wrote, *“But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts; and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear” (1 Peter 3:15).* In *Romans 8:31-35* you will find Paul’s reasons for our hope of eternal life in the form of five questions.

1. *“If God be for us, who can be against us?”* Can the law and justice of God defeat God’s purpose to save us? Can the world, the flesh, or the devil defeat us? No, not if God is FOR us.
2. *“If God spared not his own Son, but delivered Him up for us all,”* shall He not with Him also freely give us all things that Christ purchased by His death? All things necessary to save us and bring us to glory are freely given to us in and by the Lord Jesus Christ.
3. *“Who shall lay anything to the charge of God’s elect?”* God’s elect are justified in His sight and cannot be charged with their sins. God has imputed Christ’s righteousness to them, and they have eternal life from Him. God gives them faith to believe in Christ, and they shall not perish.
4. *“Who is he that condemneth?”* It is Christ who died, and the fact that the Father raised Him from the grave and exalted Him to His right hand as our forerunner and head assures us of that place. All for whom Christ died and arose SHALL be saved eternally!
5. *“Who can separate us from the love of God?”* God’s love for His people in Christ is an everlasting, unchangeable love in Christ! Those whom God loves, He saves, and they cannot perish.
