Christian Leadership School Courses Phase III

<u>NOTE</u>: All courses <u>must</u> be completed in order to graduate. Also, each student that's graduating <u>must</u> complete an assignment titled "Contemporary Issues Affecting the Church". This paper must be at least two typed, double-spaced pages with at least five different scripture references. If you are a student not completing this phase for graduation, you may take any course that's offered by registering for that course.

1079 Survey of John

This course will focus on the fourth Gospel and its uniqueness. It will identify the specific features that characterizes John's gospel and distinguish it from the Synoptic Gospels, with emphasis on John's writings and the ministry of Jesus Christ.

1089 Survey of Romans

This course will engage in an overview of major issues presented in Paul's doctrinal letter to the Roman Christians. Students will come to recognize each doctrinal truth presented in the book.

3007 History of Baptists

This course will examine the roots of the Baptist faith. Students will study the historical development of the Baptist denomination.

7005 Christian Evangelism

This course will teach the basic steps in developing a program of evangelism. Students will discover the appropriate Scriptures to use, and the methods, techniques, and media best suited for witnessing to nonbelievers.

9005 Writing Technique II

This course will focus on the Certificate of Progress Program (COPP) writing requirement for Phase 3. Emphasis will be placed on the writing of documented research and the development of other skills necessary to complete the writing assignment in this phase. This course will help introduce the students to the library and the use of reference materials.

9018 Great Hymns of the Church: Their Origin and Meaning

This course will make available a study on several of the great hymns of the church. The course investigates the history of the words and the music as well as the importance of the story in the song. It will look at the meaning of the song for that day and make application of the song for the day.
