

The meeting was held in Room A/Session Room in the Fellowship Hall building with a quorum of Elders in attendance. Pastor Connie moderated the meeting.

Active Membership: 160 as of September 8

Actions of Session:

- Approved donating 100% (after expenses, if any) of the money earned by the **Hot Dog Sale** at the Harvest Festival to "Haiti, Help, and Hope".
- Approved donating (after expenses) funds earned at the **New Year's Day Meal** as follows: 50% to Presbyterian Disaster Assistance and 50% to the Carthage Food Pantry
- Approved as presented the minutes of the Stated Session meeting of August 11, 2024.
- Ratified Darrell Cole's resignation from the session.
- Approved the scheduling of a Congregational meeting for Sunday, September 29 to elect two members
 of the congregation to serve on the Elder Nominating Committee and to approve the committee as a
 whole.
- Approved Audrey Chacon as the second elder to serve on the Elder Nominating Committee.
- Approved the collection of **Food Bags for the Sandhills Coalition** in conjunction with our Homecoming and Revival.
- Approved the use of the church van to transport youth and adults to the September 29 **Sunday Fun Day** events.
- The Financial Report for August 2024 was received as information.

Approved the following document as presented: **Process for Addressing a Pastor's Terms of Call**. It will be added to the Culdee Manual of Operation.
