Barton Stone: Chose the name "Christians" based on Acts 11:26

Campbell: Chose "Disciples" - definition "learners" less pretentious

Two branches that left movement:

Churches of Christ - Non- Instrumental (New Testament did not require instruments in worship)

Independents - No involvement in church societies/conventions because New Testament did not describe them

Church of Christ Church (Disciples of Christ)

We are only a part of one Christian Church to which all church bodies belong. Within that one church, we call ourselves Disciples of Christ.
