

LEVITICUS

Offerings and Sacrifices

- 1- The burnt offering—A voluntary offering to God as an expression of praise and submission to him. The entire animal was burned up on the altar.
- 2- The grain offering – A voluntary offering given as thanks to God for his goodness and provision.
- 3- The peace offering – A voluntary offering expressing appreciation to God and to others for the joy of their friendship. The animal was eaten by the worshiper and family or friends.
- 4 - The sin offering – Anyone guilty of unintentional sin or wrong was required to make this sacrifice.
- 5- The guilt offering – This sacrifice was required from anyone guilty of breaching the law of God.
