Psalms 119:1 NRS

Happy are those whose way is blameless, who **walk** in the law of the Lord.

Psalms 119:45 NRS

I shall **walk** at liberty, for I have sought your precepts.

Psalms 138:7 NRS

Though I **walk** in the midst of trouble, you preserve me against the wrath of my enemies; you stretch out your hand, and your right hand delivers me.

Proverbs 2:7 NRS

He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who **walk** blamelessly,

Proverbs 2:20 NRS

Therefore **walk** in the way of the good, and keep to the paths of the just.

Proverbs 3:23 NRS

You will **walk** on your way securely and your foot will not stumble.

Proverbs 4:12 NRS

When you **walk**, your step will not be hampered; and if you run, you will not stumble.

Proverbs 8:20 NRS

I **walk** in the way of righteousness, along the paths of justice,

Proverbs 9:6 NRS

Lay aside immaturity, and live, and **walk** in the way of insight."

Proverbs 20:7 NRS

The righteous **walk** in integrity— happy are the children who follow them!

Proverbs 28:26 NRS

Those who trust in their own wits are fools; but those who **walk** in wisdom come through safely.

Isaiah 2:5 NRS

Come, let us **walk** in the light of the Lord!

Isaiah 30:21 NRS

And when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left, your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way; **walk** in it."

Isaiah 40:31 NRS

Those who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall **walk** and not faint.

Isaiah 43:2 NRS

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you **walk** through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.

Jeremiah 6:16 NRS

Jeremiah 31:9 NRS

Matthew 11:5 NRS

The blind receive their sight, the lame **walk**, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them.

John 5:8 NRS

John 5:9 NRS

John 8:12 NRS
