1. Put God first in your living and giving by practicing gratitude and generosity!

"Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will reap generously. Each should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (II Corinthians 9:6-7)

Some people, eager for money, have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many kinds of grief." (I Timothy 6:9-12)

Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, "Who is the Lord?" Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God." (Proverbs 30:7-9)
