## THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT December 11, 2022

#### **Note from our Pastor**

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT! Time walks fast. We have only 10 days before Christmas to prepare for the coming of the Messiah. Let us strive to make these days eventful moments for conversion.

The punch line of an advertisement says, "What's in your wallet?" I would like to copy that as the punch line of the gospel today but with a twist and paraphrase it this way, "WHAT'S IN YOUR HEART?" If your wallet keeps your money, credit cards, driver's license, your heart holds your love and care, your hope and faith, and your life. Your wallet keeps your identification on earth, while your heart keeps what can identify you in heaven. Your wallet keeps your material sustenance while your heart keeps your spiritual nourishment.

If our eyes become blind to our neighbor's needs, our hearts will remind us about the situations of the destitute, the poor, the homeless, and the people who are deformed or disabled. Our hearts will let us feel our neighbor's pains and sorrow, brokenness and helplessness. Sometimes, our eyes deceive us, but our hearts unveil to us the truth of life.

This deception and truth are embedded in John's question to Jesus and in Jesus' answer. John's disciples asked Jesus, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we LOOK for another?" Their eyes were blind, and likewise their hearts. So Jesus opened them by saying to them: "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them..." Jesus clearly revealed to them what the KINGDOM OF HEAVEN would be like.

That is Jesus! He is the savior that gives hope to the blind, the lame, lepers, and poor. When they are desperate and confused, he serenades them with this love song of our times: "Hello! Is it me you're looking for? Because I wonder where you are and I wonder what you do; are you somewhere feeling lonely? Tell me how to win your heart for I haven't got a clue but let me start by saying I LOVE YOU!"

To you who are desperate and hopeless, to you who are poor and homeless, to you who are rejected and discriminated, remember, JESUS LOVES YOU!

#### Eucharist Revival

The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins with the preparation of the gifts and the altar. As the ministers prepare the altar, representatives of the people bring forward the bread and wine that will become the Body and Bood of Christ. The celebrant blesses and praises God for these gifts and places themon the altar, the place of the Eucharistic sacrifice. In addition to the bread and wine, monetary gifts for the support of the Church and the care of the poor may be brought forward. The Prayer over the Offerings concludes this preparation and disposes all for the Eucharistic Prayer.




