# Twenty - Second Sunday in Ordinary Time August 28, 2022

The prophet Sirach reminds us how to earn the affection of a loving God with these words:

"My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God."

Certainly, the prophet encourages us to practice HUMILITY! "Humility does not mean that we always aspire for the lowest places. Humility does not mean we should be ill-at-ease with the honors given us. Humility is the spirit of detachment." It is a virtue that charms God's love. It is the mother of many virtues, because from it knowledge, realism, honesty, strength, and dedication are born. If this desirable quality becomes the heartbeat of our hearts, Jesus promises us: "...the one who humbles himself will be exalted... blessed indeed will you be... you will be repaid at the resurrection..."

Read this story of a rich man who got stuck in a long line at the airport because of security reasons:

The rich man at the head of the line was mad. He screamed at the attendant, "I want to be seated now! I cannot wait in this line. I have first class tickets." He went on and on. The attendant behind the counter was patiently trying to explain to him the problems but he would not listen. Finally, the rich man shouted, "Do you know who I am?" Immediately, the attendant picked up the microphone and announced, "Attention, we have a gentleman here who doesn't know who he is. If anyone can identify him, please come to the front desk."

Most of the time, pride and money, if not guarded well, will lead us to dishonor, shame and humiliation. It was pride that changed angels into devils; it is humility that makes people become saints. Therefore, let us practice humility in words and deeds. You might ever know, as early as today, you might be on your journey towards sainthood.
