NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

The second reading is from Philippians. St. Paul tells us to always rejoice in the Lord and not to worry about anything. He encourages us to pray and give thanks to God, and then we will experience God's peace.

This reading emphasizes the theme of joyful anticipation. St. Paul reminds us that joy comes from knowing God is near. When we focus on God and His love for us, we can find happiness even in difficult times.

St. Paul also talks about the peace of God. This peace is not like the peace the world gives. It is a deep sense of calm and trust that God is taking care of us. When we feel anxious or worried, we can turn to God in prayer and experience His peace.

We are invited to rejoice and be at peace. St. Paul's words remind us to focus on God and His blessings. As we prepare for Christmas, let's remember to find joy and peace in our relationship with God and share that joy with others.
