### Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 5, 2023 Note from our Pastor

Spiritual writer, Henry Nouwen, once said: "Often we want to be somewhere other than where we are, or even to be someone other than who we are. We tend to compare ourselves constantly with others and wonder why we are not as rich, as intelligent, as simple, as generous, or as saintly as they are. Such comparisons make us feel guilty, ashamed, or jealous. It is very important to realize that our vocation is hidden in where we are and who we are. We are unique human beings, each with a call to realize in life what nobody else can, and to realize it in the concrete context of the here and now. We will never find our vocations by trying to figure out whether we are better or worse than others. We are good enough to do what we are called to do. Be yourself!"

But in our gospel today, Jesus explicitly unveils who we are: "the SALT of the earth and the LIGHT of the world!" As SALT- giving flavor to life, and as LIGHT- giving hope to people, you are not competing with others if you are better than them or not. It is imperative that you do what God calls you to do to perpetuate his presence in your life, make sure that good overcomes evil, ensures that you make a difference in the life of others.

And today, in a world so full of social and political turmoil and immense human suffering, people of faith, love and hope: ARE YOU READY TO BECOME SALT OF THE EARTH; ARE YOU READY TO BECOME LIGHT OF THE WORLD?

In Christ, however, what was lost by sin has been restored and renewed even more wondrously by grace. Jesus, the new Adam, "was crucified under Pontius Pilate," offering himself up as a sacrifice so that we may receive the inheritance that was lost by sin. By freely offering his life on the cross, Christ allows us to *become the children of God* (Jn 1:12) and to inherit the Kingdom of God. St. Peter reminds us, *Christ himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed* (I Pt 2:24). 
