NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Our first reading for this week is from the first book of Kings, and it has to do with Solomon, the son of David and Bathsheba, the great Israelite king who built the temple, and who eventually became a problematic figure in Israelite history. This passage puts us right at the very beginning of Solomon's reign, when he was just a young man—untried, inexperienced, likely beset by all sorts of selfdoubt. And Yahweh appears to Solomon in a dream and says, "Ask something of me and I will give it to you." This is an extraordinary moment—and let's attend with some care to Solomon's answer.

Solomon provides an example for all who are in leadership roles, whether in the Church, in politics, in schools, or in communities. Solomon recognizes that leadership is an act of service and sacrifice.

So when God asks this young leader what he wants, he does not ask for something to make himself more comfortable. Instead he asks for wisdom, which will benefit all of the people he will rule. A good leader is more concerned with others than himself. We should pray for all of our leaders to recognize and live this.

In this day and age, it is important that we pray for our leaders. Prayers storming heaven for leaders to value selflessness and embrace serving others. Maybe, just maybe, if we saw more of that from our leaders and a little less bravado, maybe our world would be in a different place!
